She'll take us beachcombing for glass floats (everyone is guaranteed a float)! She will also share the history and lore of the area as we **visit Charleston, Cape Arago, and Shore Acres**. She'll enlighten us with the fascinating **real-life story of Louis Simpson**, and the mansion and gardens he built as a Christmas present for his wife Cassie. Their tale is one of romance and tragedy played out on this lonely wild spot overlooking the roaring Pacific. **Shore Acres State Park** really comes alive during the holidays. A community tradition was born in 1987, when the **Friends of Shore Acres decided to "string a few lights"** to help celebrate the holidays. That first season, 6,000 miniature lights, one Christmas tree, and the decorated Garden House drew 9,000 visitors. Now, **more than a quarter million lights** - many Christmas trees, lighted sculptures, a new performance pavilion, and a beautifully decorated Garden House, draw 40,000 to 50,000 visitors! We'll head back to the Mill where a delicious **all-you-can eat crab feed** awaits... yummm!

Today we'll head up **the world's most famous coastline, with a few photo stops on the way**. Enjoy a **delicious lunch overlooking the ocean at the Adobe Resort**.
